When is the Smoke on the Plains BBQ & Music Fest?

June 6, 7 & 8 at High Park

Where is the event?

High Park, 2801 E. James St. in Derby

How much does it cost?

The event is free and open to the public.

Where do I park?

Parking will be available from James St. (two paved parking lots). These will be used for the Friday night and Saturday night concerts. They will also be available Saturday, but parking is encouraged in the grass lot accessible from Madison Ave. All parking is free.

ADA parking is available near the Zimmerman Family Shelter. Must have tag or placard.

In the case of wet weather, we will need to shuttle from Derby High School. Park in the south parking lot at Derby High School (920 N. Rock Rd.) accessible from Madison Ave. We will have four shuttle buses running to and from the park.

When is the People's Choice Contest?

The People's Choice Contest will be held Saturday, June 8 from 1 to 3 p.m. (new time!) Purchase tasting kits just south of the amphitheater and walk up the hill to the west to the tent to taste eight, 1 oz. samples of competition pulled pork and vote for your favorite. Tasting kits are \$5.

What bands are playing on the Security 1st Mainstage?

- Paramount, and 80s cover band, is performing on June 7 from 7 to 10 p.m.
- Haymakers are performing on June 8 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Morrison County is performing on June 8 at 6 p.m. followed by Mountain Deer Revival at 7 p.m.

Can I bring my dog?

Yes, dogs are allowed at the park. Please pick up after them. Please do not take them in the BBQ team area as they are preparing food.

Where is the lost and found/first aid station?

You will find this at the enclosed shelter located in the southwest area of the park.

Will there be an ATM onsite?

No. There will not be an ATM at the park. Food vendors, beer garden and carnival will accept debit/credit cards.
