### **Recognition of Jack Pulley**

Background:

- Jack Pulley is a long-time Derby resident and a strong advocate for the Derby community and for McConnell Air Force Base. Throughout his years of civic devotion to Derby, he has served this community with earnest commitment to:
    - Derby Planning Commission, 1999 to 2008
    - Derby Chamber of Commerce, 1976 to present; McConnell Action Group, 2017 to present
    - Derby Rotary Club, 2010 to present
    - Friends of McConnell, board chair
    - Golden Eagle, fourth among seven selected since 1990
    - Air Mobility Command Civic Leader Council, member
  - He became an honorary commander for the 381st Missile Wing in 1976. With his selfless civic leadership, he has cemented an unbreakable bond between Derby and the Air Force Base.
  - Last month, the prestigious Tampa Bay trophy was awarded to Jack Pulley in Grapevine, Texas to provide national recognition of his lifetime of service to McConnell Air Force Base and its airmen.
